Warranty and Installation Information
(Please read this page before beginning the installation)

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GENERAL INFORMATION

- When installing this product, the pipes must be flushed clean where the product is being installed.
 - The water pressure must be tested. Where the water pressure exceeds 500Kpa. an approved pressure reducing valve must be fitted.
 - Always fit isolating taps to the hot and cold inlet connections in accordance with national plumbing code AS3500.
 - Ensure the hoses are not twisted or stretched, are not under tension and not bent to a radius less than 25mm when being installed.
 - If the water temperature exceeds 80°C an approved water tempering valve must be fitted.
- Failure to comply with all of the above instructions will void all warranties.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure all pipes and hoses have been flushed.
2. Fit the flexible inlet hoses. Ensure that the blue braided hose is connected to the right hand side of the tap and the red braided hose is connected to the left.
3. Position hoses through the hole in surface.
4. Place horseshoe fixing clamp and washer to the underside of the surface.
5. Fit threaded studs through the clamp to the tap body and tighten firmly.
6. Connect the hoses to the isolating stop taps or similar valves (if previously fitted).
7. Turn on isolating stop taps and check for leaks.

Please note: this product is to be installed by a qualified plumber. To make a warranty claim, the details of the installer must be provided.

WARRANTY INFORMATION

Ceramic Cartridge carries a 10 Year Replacement Warranty
Parts carry a 12 months Warranty.
